Conflict Materials Statement

Titan supports and respects the protection of internationally proclaimed human rights for all, including the basic human rights of our employees and workers within our supply chain. We believe in treating people with respect and dignity, and incorporate these principles into our business processes and relationships. Titan also expects our suppliers to adhere to the same high standards.

As part of our global approach to the protection of human rights, Titan is committed to the ethical sourcing of minerals used in our products. We are assessing whether our products contain tantalum, tin, tungsten or gold derived from ores mined in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and adjoining countries. These minerals are commonly used in electronics and other products. Some of the mining operations in the DRC are controlled by warring militias who are financing armed conflict with profits from the sale of these minerals. This on-going conflict has been linked to human rights violations, labour abuses, and environmental degradation.

It is Titan's goal not to purchase product materials containing minerals whose sale financed armed conflict in the DRC. The global supply chain for these minerals is complex, and tracing the minerals in our products to their source is a challenge. Titan is working diligently with our suppliers and subcontractors to improve and systematically address the process for sourcing minerals that are "conflict-free."

Recognizing the complexity of the issue, Titan appreciates the need for broad collaboration to reach our objectives. In addition we expect our suppliers (and their suppliers) to exercise due diligence on the source and chain of custody of the tantalum, tin, tungsten and gold used in components or products they supply to us. Based upon information learned through the due diligence efforts, we believe we will make important progress toward ensuring responsible mineral sourcing and improved transparency throughout the supply chain.
